### Sporting Regulations – GENERAL

#### 1.1 TITLE:

Dragon Kart Club Ltd – 2016 Race Events

#### JURISDICTION:

The Dragon Kart Club is organised and administered by Dragon Kart Club Ltd in accordance with the General Regulations of the Royal Automobile Club Motor Sports Association (Incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the F.I.A.), the MSA specific regulations for karting, where applicable and these Championship Regulations.

#### 1.3 COMPETITOR ELIGIBILITY:

- 1.3.1 Entrants must be in possession of a valid 2016 MSA Entrants Licence and hold a valid membership card for an ABkC Kart Club. Competitors under the age of 18 must be accompanied by the holder of a Kart PG Entrant's licence who must sign on as Entrant of that competitor.
- 1.3.2 Drivers and Entrant/Drivers must hold a valid membership card for an ABkC Kart Club and be in possession of a valid 2016 MSA Competition Licence and the minimum grade 'Kart National B (Novice)'.
- 1.3.3 All necessary documentation must be presented for checking at all rounds when signing on including all Novices.

#### 1.5 SCORING: for Drivers at Race Events

1.5.1 Individual rounds will be scored on the following basis:

Heats: Grid positions for the Final on the day will be calculated from the competitors' performance in the heats on the following basis:

1 <sup>st</sup>	0 points
2 <sup>nd</sup>	2 points
3 <sup>rd</sup>	3 points
4 <sup>th</sup>	4 points

DNS & Exclusion Max grid for the Event + 1

To resolve a tie in the heat points, the driver with the fastest Qualifying time will take the highest grid position or the best result in Heat 1.

#### 1.6 AWARDS:

- 1.6.1 Trophies will be awarded on the ratio of 1 in three drivers, up to maximum 6<sup>th</sup> place entered for each class and Novices entered in each class.
- 1.6.2 Presentations: Trophies are to be provided for the end of meeting presentation ceremony. If a Trophy Winner is not present then the Club reserves the right to withdraw the Trophy.
- 1.6.3 Title to all Trophies: In the event of any Provisional Results being revised after any provisional presentations and such revisions affect the distribution of any awards the Competitors concerned must return such awards to the Club in good condition within 7 days.

### 2 SPORTING REGULATIONS – JUDICIAL PROCEDURES

2.1 Race Events: In accordance with Section C of the current 2016 MSA Yearbook and the 2016 Karting Penalty Table of mandatory penalties as appended to these regulations.

### 3 TECHNICAL REGULATIONS

- 3.1 The Dragon Kart Club Race Events are for competitors participating in karts which conform to the MSA Technical and Safety Regulations as detailed in the 2016 MSA Yearbook and MSA Kart Year Book.
- 3.2 Eligible classes are as detailed in the 2016 MSA Kart race Year Book and any KTE as appropriate. Senior Max includes additional class of Senior Max Masters for the over 35 years. The Masters Class minimum weight 177kg (as per D1.11)
